



Privacy Policy

This privacy policy sets out the information gathering and dissemination practices for this web site by TSX Group Inc. and its wholly-owned subsidiaries, TSX Inc. and TSX Venture Exchange Inc. (collectively, the "TSX" or "we"). By using this web site, you are consenting to this privacy policy and the collection, use and disclosure of your personal information by the TSX as outlined in this privacy policy. We may update this privacy policy from time to time and you are responsible for periodically reviewing the most current version of this privacy policy on this web site. Your continued use of the site or submission of information will be deemed your conclusive acceptance of the updated privacy policy.

Collecting and Using Information:

Either before or when we collect information about you on our web site (such as your name, address, phone number, e-mail address or payment information), we will tell you how it will be used. We will limit the information we collect to what we need for those purposes. If we wish to use your information for any other purpose, we will obtain your consent before using the information.

Releasing Information:

We may provide your information to other persons, but only if:

- we have your consent;
- we provide the information to our service providers, suppliers or agents who assist us in serving you and they have agreed to abide by our privacy policy; or
- we are required to do so by law, regulation or court order.

Providing Information Access and Accuracy:

On your request, we will use commercially reasonable efforts to provide you with the information that we retain about you. We will make every reasonable effort to keep your information accurate and up-to-date.

Respecting and Responding to Your Privacy Concerns:

You have the option to refuse or withdraw consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your information, and we will respect your choices. We will investigate and respond to your concerns about any aspect of our handling of your information.

"Cookies":

Some pages on our web site use a technology called "cookies". A cookie is a token that a server gives to your browser when you access a web site. Cookies are capable of storing many types of data. Cookies help provide additional functionality to the web site or to help us analyze web site usage more accurately. For instance, our server may set a cookie that keeps you from having to enter a password more than once during a visit to one of our web sites. In all cases in which cookies are used, we will not collect personally identifiable information except with your explicit permission. Automatic Collection of Information:

In some cases, we may collect information about you that is not personally-identifiable.
