



TMX Group – Equity Financing Statistics June 2011 Toronto Stock Exchange, TSX Venture Exchange

July 7, 2011 (TORONTO) – TMX Group today announced its financing activity on Toronto Stock Exchange and TSX Venture Exchange for June 2011.

Toronto Stock Exchange welcomed 31 new issuers during June 2011, including 12 exchange traded funds and 8 mining companies. This represents a 107% increase over May 2011 and a 121% increase over June 2010. Initial public offerings (IPO) were up significantly during June 2011; there were 20 IPOs in June 2011 compared to 11 in May 2011 and 7 in June 2010. Total financings raised during the month were up 129% over May 2011 and 22% compared to June 2010.

TSX Venture Exchange welcomed 20 new companies to the Exchange during June 2011, 11 of which were from the mining sector. This compares to 17 new listings in May 2011 and 11 listings in June 2010. In June 2011, total financings raised increased by 96% over June 2010, though they were down compared to May 2011. 6 companies graduated to Toronto Stock Exchange during the month.

Issuer market capitalization on both Exchanges continued to exceed 2010 levels.
