Dow Jones Canada TopCap Style Indexes Change

Dow Jones Indexes has completed its quarterly review of the Dow Jones Canada TopCap Style Indexes. All changes are effective Dec. 24, 2001.

Canadian Tire Corp. (CTR.A), a retailer specializing in automotive parts and gasoline, and Goldcorp Inc. (G), a gold-mining company, will be added to the Dow Jones Canada TopCap Value Index and the broader Dow Jones Canada TopCap Index.

National airline Air Canada (AC), supply-chain management firm Descartes Systems Group Inc. (DSG), small-business telecommunications provider GT Group Telecom Inc.(GTG.A) and industrial technology company Westaim Corp. (WED) will be deleted from the Dow Jones Canada TopCap Growth Index and the broader Dow Jones Canada TopCap Index. All have been reclassified as small-cap stocks.

Bell Canada International Inc. (BI), which operates telecommunications companies in Latin America, will be removed from the Dow Jones Canada TopCap Growth Index, the Dow Jones Canada TopCap Index and the Dow Jones Canada Total Market Index for failing to pass the Dow Jones quarterly review screens.

Canfor Corp. (CFP), a forest products company, will be removed from Dow Jones Canada TopCap Value Index and the broader Dow Jones Canada TopCap Index. It has been reclassified as a small-cap stock.

The Dow Jones Canada TopCap Index includes the large- and mid-cap segments of the Dow Jones Canada Total Market Index. Growth and value versions are also calculated.
